

The Eldon City Council met in special session at the Eldon City Hall on Thursday, May 24, 2018. Council members answering roll call were Patti Durflinger, Brian Keasling and Jane Sapp. The meeting was called to order at 4:00pm by Brian Keasling. Council members Craig Brown and Mike McClure was absent. Mayor Potts was also absent.

Discussion was held on extending the lease with Cardinal School District through June 2019. The rate increase of \$750.00 would take effect October 1, 2018. Discussion was to allow parking on the west side of the building on the east side on the parking lot. They school will be given first option to lease the building next year. Motion by Sapp, second by Durflinger, all aye, motion carried. Patti Durflinger stated that Joel Pederson mentioned painting on the inside of the building. It was stated from a school representative that it would be a neutral color. The school Board will not meet until June 18, 2018 to consider approving the extended lease.

Discussion was held on purchasing a banner for American Gothic Days. Jerry Potts will contribute \$100.00 towards the cost of the banner. Jane Sapp asked if the city would have to rent a lift to place the banner and take the banner down. Jane Sapp stated that donations should be taken up for the cost of the banner. Brian Keasling stated that Gothic Days is a GATE event. Motion by Keasling to contribute \$150.00 to the cost of the banner, second by Sapp, motion carried.

Motion by Sapp to adjourn, second by Durflinger, all aye, motion carried.
