

The Eldon City Council met in special session at the Eldon City Hall on Wednesday, August 6, 2019 with Mayor Potts presiding. Council members answering roll call were Brian Keasling, George Loerzel, Jane Sapp and Patti Durflinger. The meeting was called to order at 4:00pm.

Craig Brown entered the meeting at 4:03pm.

Jim Warner was present to update the council on the sewer project to improve the sanitary sewer system. The discussion was focused on schedule and costs of proposed improvements, and on the methods of funding and prospects of a successful CDBG application.

Discussion was held on the request from Cardinal School to pump their wastewater to Eldon for treatment. The council is favorable accepting Cardinal School as a sewer customer; subject to completing an agreement of the terms and conditions of the service that will be discussed at the September regular meeting.

Discussion was held on a community mural. Motion by Keasling to pursue the mural, second by Loerzel, all aye, motion carried.

Discussion was held on surveying city properties.

Motion by Keasling to adjourn, second by Durflinger, all aye, motion carried.
