

The Eldon City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, November 10, 2020 at Eldon Library Hall with Mayor Potts presiding. Council members answering roll call were Brian Keasling, Stacey Doree, Jane Sapp and David Showman. The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm. Tom Bedford was absent.

Motion by Doree to authorize amending the agenda by adding Resolution 2020-8 – A Resolution approving a post-issuance compliance policy and removing Christmas decorations, second by Keasling, all aye, motion carried.

Consent Agenda – The Consent Agenda consisted of minutes from October 13, 2020. Motion by Doree to authorize the minutes, second by Showman, all aye, motion carried.

Motion by Showman to authorize the bills, second by Keasling, all aye, motion carried.

PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS – None.

City Clerk – No report.

Public Works – Jerred Reed was present to update the council on the repair work done to the backhoe.

Wapello County Law Enforcement – Marty Wonderlin was present. A written report was received.

Motion by Sapp to authorize PCS to connect security cameras, second by Keasling, all aye, motion carried.

New Business – Motion by Showman to authorize Resolution 2020-8 - A Resolution approving a post-issuance compliance policy, roll call vote taken, all aye, motion carried.

Discussion was held on issuing fines for vicious dogs located at 810 W. Walnut Street. The city received a written complaint and received numerous phone calls regarding the vicious dogs running at large. Sean Coulter was present to explain to the council the issues he had with the vicious dogs.

Motion by Keasling to serve a three day notice to remove the vicious dogs being kept, sheltered or harbored at 810 W. Walnut Street from city limits and issue a \$500.00 municipal infraction, second by Sapp, all aye, motion carried.

Discussion was held on vicious dogs located at 209 Selma Street. The city has received numerous complaints on the dogs. Motion by Sapp to serve a three day notice to remove the vicious dogs being kept, sheltered or harbored at 209 Selma Street from city limits, and issue a \$500.00 municipal infraction, second by Keasling, all aye, motion carried.

Discussion was held on city health/dental insurance. Motion by Showman to authorize the health/dental insurance plan, second by Doree, all aye, motion carried.
