

The Eldon City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, August 29, 2023 at Eldon City Hall with Mayor Potts presiding. Council members answering roll call were Tom Bedford, Carl Culp, Brandon Potts and David Showman. Stacey Doree was absent. The meeting was called to order at 4:00pm.

Motion by Showman to authorize the agenda, second by Culp, all aye, motion carried.

Motion by Showman to authorize the pickle ball equipment agreement, second by Potts, all aye, motion carried. There shall not be a rental fee. A deposit fee shall be paid in the amount of \$50.00 per day. Rentals may be made at city hall and the library.

Motion by Potts to authorize Josh Vose and Sawyer Manley to attend Emergency Medical Technician Class, second by Showman, all aye, motion carried. The cost of the class is \$799.20 each.

Discussion was held on hiring a part time public works employee. Pay will depend on qualifications. A pre-employment physical, drug test, and background check shall be complete. There will be a ninety-day probation period. Applications will be accepted until September 15<sup>th</sup> at 12:00pm. Council member Culp and Bedford will review applications on September 15<sup>th</sup>. A special meeting has been scheduled for September 20<sup>th</sup> at 4:00pm for interviews. Motion by Culp to advertise for the position, second by Bedford, all aye, motion carried

Motion by Potts to accept the quote from Sunset Builders for the interior of city hall in the amount of \$15,500.00, second by Showman, all aye, motion carried. The insulation and interior wall will be done by volunteer work.

Motion by Bedford to adjourn, second by Culp, all aye, motion carried.
