Motion by Potts to authorize building permit for Kim Larue, second by Doree, all aye, motion carried.

Discussion on nuisance abatements. City council members will gather a list of properties to send a notice to. If the notice is not complied with, a nuisance abatement order shall be sent.

Discussion was held on Cardinal's flow meter installation. City of Eldon shall not take responsibility for the flow meter.

Derick Clark shall obtain waste water testing from Eldon's lagoons every week.
