Rick Teed with Garden & Associates was present to discuss the sewer smoke testing results.

Garden and Associates will provide the documents to obtain bids to repair city issues. Bids will be taken until October 14, 2025 at noon. Bids shall be opened and may be awarded at the regular meeting on October 14, 2025.

Carrie Teninty will notify homeowners of their deficiencies from the sewer smoke test.

Carl Culp was present to discuss the sewer smell in his home. Deb McClure and Andrew Birch stated the city can not make residents repair their sewer venting issues.

Jane Sapp was present to ask the city about the special meeting and taking action at the meeting. The city code states the city can have a special meeting with written notice. The agenda was posted on Friday, September 26, 2025 for the special meeting on October 1, 2025. The city has not changed the regular meeting day. This is required to be done by ordinance.
